## The KC Metro Area expression of the Freedom Pens Project 2007 is under way!



The Northland, Independence, and KC Woodturners chapters of the AAW are cooperating in purchasing and creating a BUNCH of SlimLine pens that will be distributed to our US troops serving in the Middle East. We'll add our energies and creativity to the hundreds of turners who've created and delivered more than 74,000 pens to those troops in just three short years.

#### What we have:

- Access to the KC Woodturners' Clubhouse (and the small gaggle of lathes that live there!) on two Saturdays, November 10 and November 17, probably from 8:30 to noonish each day, and maybe longer if we have people turning.
- Four hundred (400!) SlimLine pen kits are in hand and ready to build.
- About 450 wood pen blanks with even more promised.
- About 20 pounds of red, white, and blue Corian material to use as accents or to make entire pens from, if someone chooses to.
- Special CA glue for the Corian.
- A growing list of volunteer turners looking forward to spending some time talkin' and turnin' on those two Saturdays.

#### What we need still:

- Mandrels and bushings for all of the lathes so we can use every single lathe for the whole time, should we have that many volunteer turners at once. All of the KCWT lathes are Morse Taper #2 spindles.
- Pen assembly presses (one or two would be great, please).
- End mills (only for the 7 mm tubes)
- Glue for assembly (some like thick CA, others prefer epoxy, but not all week-end drying glues, please)
- Abrasives (to at least 320 or 400 grit for shellac or lacquer based finishes, generally higher for CA and some other such finishes)
- Finishes of choice (Hut's CrystalCoat, Deft's lacquer finishes--brushed, not sprayed, appropriate fast drying Behlens, Liberon, or Mylands products)

**The hope is** that KC area turners will adopt this program, make it their own, and come with lathe tools in hand, as well as their own preferences for sanding and finishing, ready to treat the troops special.

The KC Woodturners club house is located in the basement of the McCray Lumber Co building, one block west of I-35, on 67th Street, on the south side of the street just west of the railroad tracks. There's plenty of parking.
