April Showers

Spring is here and many of you will be spending more time in the garden than in the shop. This would be a good time to think about a little spring cleaning in your shop. As they say "A clean shop is a safe shop". Now is the time to do those little things that you normally don't think about when you are in the middle of a turning session, or even after a turning session when you are tired and just want to go in a get a bite to eat and watch some TV and relax after a hard day in the shop. If you turn wet wood, make sure that you've gotten all those nice curly shavings off of your tools and benches. Rust can happen very quickly in this climate. Take the time to clean and lubricate your woodturning equipment to keep it in tiptop shape. This is also a good time to re-tune your other gear like the tablesaw and bandsaw. And don't forget the grinder. Over time, the metal particles from the tools you sharpen tend to build up in the enclosed space that surrounds your wheels. Take the covers off and blow or brush out the collection of stuff in there. Be sure and replace the covers for safety. You should also take time to true up and rebalance the wheels. Take a little time now and when you get back to it after the season is over, you'll be glad you did.

This month, your's truly will be the demonstrator. We've had a couple of requests for a natural edge piece, so I will be demonstrating a thin-walled, natural edge bowl (or two, depending on the time).
