In preparation for the holiday season Harlan Henke did a program on a Christmas tree ornament. The ornament is constructed similar to the bell ornaments Harlan presented last year with the tree top being the bell and the trunk functioning as the clapper. The tree was turned from poplar for its green color. The top was turned, hollowed and finished on the lathe with Myland's friction finish. The clapper was turned from walnut. Harlan demonstrated how he drills the parts and uses eye pins from the craft store to suspend the clapper and form the top eye to hang the ornament from.



Business Meeting


President Dave Halter opened the meeting.
