

He started with a cube which he turned between centers by placing one corner directly in the spindle and the opposite corner in a live cup center with the point removed. He starts the shape and turns a spigot so he can reverse the mounting using a chuck. He discussed techniques for turning an interrupted cut. Thank you, David, for another fine and informative presentation.
