#### **Damage Control Plugs**

Thanks to everyone who's helped with our plug orders. Our inventory is getting low so we will be asking for help getting restocked. There will be boxes of blanks at the next meeting. Please consider taking a box home and turning them by the following meeting.

Here's a table with the plug dimensions for reference. It's also on the <u>Club News</u> tab of the club website at <a href="http://www.northlandwoodturners-kc.com/Plus%20Size%20and%20Cut%20List.mht">http://www.northlandwoodturners-kc.com/Plus%20Size%20and%20Cut%20List.mht</a>

Basically, the plugs are all truncated cones with the large diameter on one end connected to the small diameter on the other end with a straight taper.

#3	3 1/4	3 1/2	2 1/8
#4	4 1/4	5 3/4	2 3/4
