June Program

The June program was the Beall Buffing System presented by Mike Thomas. Mike started by showing several configurations of wheels and bowl buffs from single wheels to three wheels on a ³/₄" x 30" shaft that required support by a live center. Recommended speed for the 8 inch wheels is 1750 RPM with 1/3 or greater horsepower motor. An old washing machine motor works well. Wheels should turn downward facing the operator.

He said the finish could be applied directly to the wood or over a hard finish such as Danish oil or Lacquer. Non-drying or slow drying finishes (Mineral oil, Linseed oil) were not recommended or Shellac because it would break down under heat.

The Tripoli compound should be generously applied to the firm wheel. The White Diamond and Carnuba Wax are applied very lightly to the medium and soft wheels respectively. Hold object to be polished against buff until it deflects slightly. As a precaution a pad should be placed under the wheel in case of a grab.




