

David Bartlett and Chip Siskey

David started with a Spiraling tool. He demonstrated use and sharpening. He also discussed the necessity to calculate the ratio of the tool orientation to the diameter of the turned piece for the best results. He then demonstrated the use and adjustments of a chatter tool on end grain.

Chip was up next with an Elf Tool that uses 1/8-inch shaft Dremel bits to spiral or texture a wood turning. He followed with a discussion of the hook and ring tools to access areas of a bowl that are difficult with other tools. He prefers the ring tool for it durability and ease of sharpening. He demonstrated how the use of the tool was much like using a gouge, but turned 90-degrees. The use of the cutting edge and bevel is the same.


