
#### **Business Meeting**

The meeting was opened by Treasurer Chip Siskey. No special news.

#### <u>Presentation – Anthony Harris</u>

Anthony's presentation was "Turning Threaded Donut Boxes". He prefers to chase the Male threads first because he finds it the most difficult. For this project he used 16 Threads Per Inch (TPI) turning at 400 RPM. He suggested standing close to lathe and to get into a rhythm. If the threads start to curve (drunken threads) Anthony said that applying slightly more pressure should straighten them. To help start the threads he cut a slight chamfer on the outside end.

For the Female threads he used the "trial and error" method to determine size. Anthony prefers it to the gauges provided with some threading sets. He used an armrest toolrest across the lathe toolrest to hold the cutting tool. He said it gives him more control and softens the contact with the wood. Once the threads were mated he turned the outside of the box. A waste block was needed to hold the project for final finishing.








